

Swift by Switchee: Installation Guide

Stage 1. Activate

Note: You **MUST** activate your Swift device before it can collect any data. **THIS IS A MUST.**


1. **Scan the QR code** (with the leaf icon) on the side of the Swift device and follow the instructions.





Stage 2. Switch it on


2. **Locate the notch** at the top of the back cover.



3. Use a screwdriver, or similar tool and carefully pop open the back cover.



4. Flip the On/Off switch to the **'On'** position.




5. **Replace the back cover**, clicking it into place.



Stage 3. Fix to wall

6. Use the **adhesive pads** provided to stick the Swift device to a suitable position on a wall.



- 7. The Swift device should be located on an internal wall.
- ✓ 1.5m+ above floor level

- ✓ Outside of zones 0-2 if in a bathroom
